> you are running 64 bit x86_64 IDL, so the .dll files should be in bin.x86_64, not in bin.x86. Are you sure that your !DLM_PATH is correct?

Well, I can't discover the !DLM_PATH inside the workbench because by the time I get to the command line, my workbench is hosed. If I run the IDL command line version, however, !DLM_Path points to the bin.x86_64 directory and the files are there. I did completely destroy my IDLWorkspace71 file before I reinstalled, and it has been recreated fresh.
