```
> I presume you are talking about PDF files. I do it like this using Coyote Graphics:
>
> cgHistoplot, cgDemodata(7), /Fill, Output='histoplot.ps'
> cgPS2PDF, 'histoplot.ps'
```

I'm not sure how the PDF functionality got missed, but I just checked in a new cgPS2Raster file with PDF functionality, so you don't have to use two steps to create a PDF file. If you download the new cgPS2Raster file here:
