> m['Longitudes'].label_angle=0
```

OK, much better.

When I put box axes around a full-global map, centered at 180 degrees East, I get "extra" longitudinal labels at 45 degrees East and 45 degrees West. Oddly both extra labels are "0". Do you see these, or do know how to get rid of them? The 45 degree labels write over the top of these "extra" labels.
