I'm not sure I said exactly that, although I do agree that for most of my needs the IDL 6.4 Workbench was nearly perfect. It was certainly stable and it did most of what I needed it to do.

But, I really don't mind the newer Eclipse Workbench. And I LOVE that I can work on LINUX machines and feel completely and utterly comfortable in IDL. *That* didn't used to happen!

Of course, if it worked properly, it would be an advantage. I still often work in IDL 7 for this very reason. But, I guess 6.4 is in the distant past.
