David Fanning writes:

- > By the way, to change the order of multiple views in a window,
- > just drag the tab of the view where you want it. The order in
- > the window will be updated automatically.

Generally speaking, if you want to create a "new" window, you grab an existing window and drag it to the edge of the workbench or current window, where an outline appears.

Fool around with it for a half-hour or so, until you get the hang of it. Eventually, you can get the windows where you want them. Don't forget where the Reset Views button is! ;-)
