You can obviously make italic versions of Postscript fonts, including the Symbol font, which is used to create Greek characters:

Set\_Plot, 'PS' Device, /Italic, /Symbol

But, there is no way in IDL that I know of to switch from an non-italic to italic and back to non-italic font inside a text string. So, if you wanted an italic theta and non-italic text otherwise, you would have to divide the text string into italic and non-italic parts and write them separately.

Seems like a lot of work for very little benefit to me. :-)
