> I tried to run IDL using command line. It just compiles the program but does not run it. Does anybody know how to fix this. I use ".run" to run the program.

On of the (many) secrets of IDL is that the .RUN command doesn't really run anything. (Actually, it runs main-level programs, but most people don't know what these are, so it's not like it counts.) RUN is a hold-over from the BASIC language from the early 1970's, when it was used to run a BASIC program. But, the command only compiles IDL procedures and functions, and for that purpose it is better to use the eponymously named .COMPILE command. :-)
