> I am trying to create multiple plots using CgWindow command.  
>  
> cgWindow, WMulti=[0,2,3]  
> cgPlot, x, y, /AddCmd  
> cgControl, output='my.ps'  
>  
> These basic commands work fine, however can't figure out the following steps yet:  
>  
> 1-) How to position the plot axis to the 3rd row and 1st column, instead of 1st row and 1st column?  
>  
> 2-) How to save the file as a letter sized (US Letter, Portrait (8.50 x 11.00 inch)) ps file?

I would do it like this:

```
PS_Start, 'my.ps', XSize=8.0, YSize=10.5, /Inches, $  
    XOffset=0.25, YOffset=0.25, /NoMatch  
cgPlot, cgDemodata(1), Layout=[2,3,3]  
PS_End
```
