> But in the spirit of "No good deed goes unpunished", the first program I tried in V8.2.2 crashed because it was expecting the calling sequence of the Coyote TimeStamp() function, rather than the different calling sequence of the ITTVIS TimeStamp() function, now ahead in the !PATH.

I've updated the TimeStamp program in the Coyote Library to use the name cgTimeStamp. While I was doing it, I used the opportunity to retire FSC_Normalize and reincarnate this program as cgNormalize. Updated versions of the Coyote Library and other libraries (Catalyst, CoyotePlus, and Coyote_Retired) can be found in the usual places.
