This concerns me, considering we take attribution seriously. In fact, for the new routines we implement, we're adding a References section at the end of the Help page. Check `IMAGE_THRESHOLD`, for example.

A timestamp routine, however, is about as generic a routine as is possible. So no, we did not borrow this idea from you; in fact, the ENVI team developed this routine for their needs and gave it to us for inclusion in IDL.

Perhaps you could provide a list of other "things in this new version of IDL that have been in the Coyote Library for a long time"? I'll do my best to address any concerns.
