The point is that if you have a function which you expect to work in double precision and you call interpolate then your results are truncated to single with no indication. I know of no other IDL built in function that does this!

This fix seems pretty straightforward. Are you *sure* you sent it to Exelis? Did you send this kind of example, so they knew what you were talking about? I think even I could probably wander through the C code and fix something like this. ;-)
