projection info parameter?
>
> projection info = {36, 6378137.0, 50.000000, -100.000000, 0.0, 0.0, WGS-84, Lambert
Azimuthal North America, units=Meters}

It is the number associated with a particular map projection. Look in
the file map_proj.txt, found somewhere in the ENVI distribution, for a
translation.
