I would appreciate any advice or suggestion. > > > Thank you, > Katya Hi Katya, If you are using new graphics, you can just use Unicode characters directly in your text, like this: y = RANDOMU(seed, 100)p=PLOT(y, TITLE='\$\U(0410,0411,0412)\$') t=TEXT(0.1,0.95, '\$\U(0413,0414,0415,0416)\$') Or, if you have a font which contains the Cyrillic characters in their ASCII locations, then you can just use ASCII characters and change the font, like this: p=PLOT(y, TITLE='ABCDEFG', FONT_NAME='Cyrillic') (You will need to determine the correct font name.)
