> Also, the documentation for the C\_SPACING keyword says,  
>  
> "If the FILL or CELL\_FILL keyword is set, this keyword can be used to control the distance, in  
centimeters, between the lines used to fill the contours"  
>  
> but c\_spacing works even if those keywords are not set...  
>  
>  
> c = dist(256)  
> contour, c, FILL=0, CELL\_FILL=0, C\_SPACING=0  
>  
> Same goes with C\_ORIENTATION  
>  
> contour, c, FILL=0, CELL\_FILL=0, C\_ORIENTATION=45  
>

Hmmp. I'd call that a bug, personally - you shouldn't be able to over-ride explicit fill settings just by changing the parameters of what would get filled. Certainly not if it doesn't say so in the documentation!
