> IDL> c = List({ t: 0})
> IDL> print, c[0].t
>      0
> IDL> c[0].t = 1
> % Attempt to store into an expression: Structure reference.
> % Execution halted at: $MAIN$
```

This is a bug IMHO. This construct should work as a structure array works (LIST is a pointer array in disguise):

```
IDL> a=replicate({t:0}, 1)
IDL> a[0].t=1
IDL> print, a[0].t
      1
```
