Hi,

just to inform you. I've been shown that it is possible to set the keyboard focus to a widget\_list widget by using the /input\_focus keyword in widget\_control. I'm not sure that this would work on

any platform, but it does under windows (7, 64 bit).

The `input_focus` keyword is specified for buttons, draw and text widgets. However, the help also says: "While this keyword will set the focus to widgets of other types, the exact location of the focus is not well defined."
