Following the trail from David Fanning ([http://www.idlcoyote.com/map\\_tips/terminator.html](http://www.idlcoyote.com/map_tips/terminator.html)) to the JHU/APL/S1R page ([http://fermi.jhuapl.edu/s1r/idl/s1rlib/local\\_idl.html](http://fermi.jhuapl.edu/s1r/idl/s1rlib/local_idl.html)) to the "Link to library web site itself" (<http://fermi.jhuapl.edu/idl/>) results in "HTTP 403 Forbidden". So the site exists but apparently needs a login. Attempting the straight ftp route described by Ray Sterner (<http://cow.physics.wisc.edu/~craigm/idl/archive/msg04856.htm>) was also unsuccessful with "no answer from fermi.jhuapl.edu".

Are the JHU/APL/S1R libraries available and if so where can they be obtained?
