> contour,x,/fill,nlevels=10
> contour,x,/downhill,nlevels=10,/noerase

> where these two images are plotted on the same quadrant of the window.
> IDL disregards the /noerase on the second plot command and puts the
> second figure in the second quadrant. What am I doing wrong?

Hi Martijn

Try the following

```
!p.multi=[0,2,2]
contour,x,/fill,nlevels=10
!p.multi=[4,2,2]
contour,x,/downhill,nlevels=10,/noerase
```

It should do the trick. If I remember correctly the first element of !p.multi contains information about the remaining plots. Setting !p.multi=[0,2,2] is also ok.
