Try the following

!p.multi=[0,2,2] contour,x,/fill,nlevels=10 !p.multi=[4,2,2] contour,x,/downhill,nlevels=10,/noerase

It should do the trick. If I remember correctly the first element of !p.multi contains information about the remaining plots. Setting !p.multi=[0,2,2] is also ok.
