> issue a command (e.g HELP, someVariable), the editor window will jump  
>  
> back to the line containing the breakpoint or STOP. I find this behavior  
>  
> extremely irritating but have not found an option to turn this off in  
>  
> the Preferences. Anyone have any thoughts?
