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Hi!

I would like to use IDL/ENVI to classify some data using SVM. Let's say I have 100 training samples, with 3 features each, like this:

```
seed = 123
xTR = RANDOMU(seed,3,100)
yTR = xTR[1,*] GT 0.5
```

and want to classify some test samples

```
xTE = RANDOMU(seed,3,100)
```

An option in IDL/ENVI seems to be ENVI_SVM_DOIT.
