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David Fanning writes:

- > What we discovered is that if you plot a map position (lat/lon) *before*
- > you enter Map_Image, it is in a different location in the window than if
- > you plot it *after* you exit Map_Image. The latitude map coordinate
- > range appears to have been bugged by Map_Image. This appears to be a
- > bug for all map projections except the Cylindrical map projection.

Well, hang-on. I haven't been able to replicate this with a simple test case, yet.

I am thinking now that the problem we were seeing might have been due to using windows with slightly different sizes in our test program. In any case, because the code is complicated, I am leaning toward programmer error at this point. Still investigating.
