> w = WINDOW(WINDOW_TITLE="My Window", DIMENSIONS=[500,100])
> t = TEXT(50, 220, "$\it Draw arrow here$", /DEVICE)
> arrow, 50, 100,200, 100
```

The ARROW procedure is a direct graphics routine. The way to draw an arrow in the Function Graphics system is to use the ARROW function:

```
ar = arrow([50, 200], [50, 50], /device, head_size=3.)
```
