You have to give more details to really figure this out, but I can give you some guesses.

I'm guessing there is a FOR loop around this snippet, maybe looping over t? And probably a WHERE statement right before this?

If so, this snippet is checking to see if the WHERE statement found any matches (ind[0] ne -1). If it does, it decrements n, saves t in tt, and skips to the next iteration of the FOR loop (the "continue").

In general, I would get a good intro book to IDL like David's or mine and read up on the basic programming constructs like loops and conditions, as well as the WHERE statement.
