No. HASH and LIST do not use _OVERLOADBRACKETSLEFTSIDE at all for performance reasons, subscripting is implemented at a lower levelOVERLOADBRACKETSLEFTSIDE methods exist only for compatibility, they can be called directly, but they are much slower then subscripting.
