> I just realized, I can use the object definition. In principle I can define my structures i a file named MyStructure\_\_Define and then simply call {MyStructure} and I'm sure this will be defined anywhere in the same way. Have to check about speed though... Might search through directories for a while.

If it is already defined, it won't search though directories. It will only search if it is NOT already defined.

By putting your structure definitions in one file, you make sure you know how that structure is defined. This should be at the top of your Best Programming Practices list.
