> The solution there was to check permissions and install ghostscript. I have access and ghostscript is installed

I think the question is, does ImageMagick know where Ghostscript is?

If this were me, I would uninstall both. Then, install GhostScript and make sure it is working. Then install ImageMagick and make sure it works. Take any good PostScript file and test from inside of IDL. You could use `cgPStoRaster` for this step.

What kind of machine are you on?
