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Mark Piper writes:

> We're looking at ways to globally change defaults in NG. One workaround is to use keyword inheritance:

>

> IDL> defaults = {color:'red', xticklen:0.02, yticklen:0.02, font_name:'Baskerville'}

> IDL> p = plot([0,1], _extra=defaults)

>

> Note that the default font must be Baskerville [1].

I have to admit, here is a tip I wouldn't have picked up from the on-line documentation. ;-)
