> Just to add a little hint, try using help:

IDL> help, STRING(year)

- > <Expression> STRING = '2011'
- > Now, you can clearly see the blanks.
- > And yes, "+" is doing concatenation: IDL> help, string(year) + string(mon) + string(day) > <Expression> STRING = '2011 10 21'
- > A piece of advice, since you're starting out: be careful with
- > "print". Sometimes, you think something has gone terribly wrong, when
- > in fact everything's OK:

IDL> a = 14.12345 print, a

- > 14.1235
- > Did IDL truncate my number? No, it's just a limitation of the default
- > print format:

IDL> print, a, FORMAT='(F10.6)'

> 14.123450
