Is there any way to implement something like a pointer to a function (as in C)?

I'd like to avoid using 'execute', but i do want something like this:

```
t = execute( 'value = '+ user_written_func +'( argument )' )
```

And a related question:

How can I compile a file that is *not* named as the function it contains without a dot command (= at runtime)?

It works ok with .compile, but not with resolve_routine.
