> setenv IDL PATH":\$HOME/shdom/idl"

>

> to my .cshrc file and now everything seems to work. (It took a while to figure out how to do that without wiping out the default path. Using the quotation marks with the colon wasn't obvious.)

The only downside to this approach is that you don't always know in which order your directories are on your IDL path, and sometimes that matters. I tend to add "project" directories individually, so I can move them around as needed. This, of course, is trivial if you set the IDL path in the IDL Workbench, since arrow buttons do the job of moving directories around and getting them in the right order for you. Otherwise, light editing of your .cshrc or IDL start-up file works, too.
