Paul Levine writes:

- > Unless I am doing something wrong (quite possible!), it seems that
- > [XYZ]CHARSIZE, as I mentioned in my first post, scales both the axis
- > labels and the axis title simultaneously. I would like to make the
- > axis labels very small without affecting the axis title.

Yes, I misunderstood your original question. Sorry.

In direct graphics, the only way to do this would be in two steps in which you draw the axis title in the second step with cgText or its equivalent. The difficulty here is that the algorithm for where to place the title text seems very difficult to come by. At least it has eluded me for quite a number of years now. Of course, I have been known to be a little overly anal about this kind of thing, so you might have better luck. :-)
