- > Is there a way to output a plot, as seen in device 'X',
- > to a file readable by Microsoft Powerpoint? I've tried
- > using encapsulated postscript but Powerpoint does not
- > show the graphic when imported.

Even though the graphic is not displayed in Powerpoint, it should still be embedded properly, i.e. when you print it to a *Postscript* printer, the graphic will appear on the printed page. If you print to a non-Postscript printer, then you will only see the bounding box.

Getting the graphic to display in Powerpoint is a bit more tricky, but I can explain it to you if you're interested.
