You can use pretty much everything in the IDE except the console (it just takes commands and doesn't do anything until the dialog is closed). This is fine, the problem is (at least for me) that once the IDE does freeze even if you close the blocking dialog it's too late once the workspace hangs that's it. Closing the dialog now will not stop the IDE hanging. You have to launch the task manager and kill the IDE then reopen it possibly losing unsaved work. This is why I consider it a bug, not so much the hanging but the fact it doesn't recover.

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
