 1) You have a save file with a *lot* of data.
 2) You'd like to restore and work with some of the data.
>
 3) It takes a long time to restore everything in the file and extract just what you want.
>

  If this is correct, then the IDLSave_File object is what you're after.
>
  Consider a save file created with:
 SAVE, var1, var2, file='idl.sav'
>
  Then you can get *just* var1 with
  sObj = OBJ_NEW('IDL_Savefile', 'idl.sav')
>
> sObj->RESTORE, 'var1'
  OBJ_DESTROY, sObj ;when you're done with the file
>
