I haven't responded because I don't honestly remember IDL 8.2, but I have a 64-bit version of IDL (8.2.3) running pretty much constantly on my Windows 7 machine and I have never experienced problems of the sort you describe. Occasionally IDL will crash, but always when I am object programming, and I presume this has to do with the object cleanup routines. I've never seen IDL crash for no reason or at random times, as far as I can recall. Sometimes IDL runs for days or weeks at a time. I just don't ever close it.
