> What do you mean with that?

I mean that because IDL objects are implemented as named structures, which require UNIQUELY named fields, you can't inherit too many objects before you run into name conflicts. (There are only so many good names for an "image", for example.) This tends to keep object hierarchies extremely shallow in practice, unless the programmer has incredible and extraordinary foresight. :-)
