 The error that I am getting is:
 % PRINT: Variable is undefined: NS (PARAM).
- > Would anyone be able to help me with this?

Instead of using ENVI_FILE_QUERY here, you want to use QUERY_TIFF:

```
void = Query_Tiff(ifname, fileInfo)
dims = fileInfo.dimensions
ns = dims[0]
nl = dims[1]
```
