It probably means that this isn't a TIFF file that you are trying to read. Who knows why? Try this code:

```
isTiff = Query_Tiff(ifname, fileInfo)
IF isTiff THEN BEGIN
    dims = fileInfo.dimensions
    ns = dims[0]
    nl = dims[1]
ENDIF ELSE BEGIN
    Print, 'Problem file: ', ifname
    Continue
ENDELSE
```
