## David Fanning writes:

- > It is not really possible to do this because so much of what is required
- > to draw the plot (data ranges, binsize, etc.) comes from the data itself
- > and not from the actual histogram.

Maybe "not possible" is the wrong way to say it. It would be possible if the information required to draw the plot were provided, but this will make some keywords required parameters, rather than the normal optional parameters, etc. It will get VERY ugly and not at all the Coyote style. :-)

Of course, if YOU wanted to do it, I couldn't stop you. :-)
