>

> jd = 0d0

> reads, '20131113 083122', jd, FORMAT='(C(CYI4,CMOI2,CDI2,1x,CHI2,CMI2,CSI2))'

> jd -= Julday(1,1,1970,0,0,0)

> jd *= 86400d0

> ncdfTime = jd

>

> Date string arrays can be handled in the same way.

Especially useful for the novice IDL programmer! ;-)
