Hello all,

I built a wrapper for a procedure (it calls many others, in turn), but the output that was important for the original program is no longer important. In fact it's quite a nuisance. I'd rather not dig down into the subroutines to add the option to turn off printing -- this would be a major effort. Is there an IDL equivalent of redirecting to /dev/null (or a text file) when calling a procedure from within another procedure? In a perfect world, it would be:

pro wrapper
  [snip]
  while i lt 1000 do begin
    [snip]
    main_procedure >& /dev/null
    [snip]
    i++
  endwhile
  [snip]
end
```
