> I found this old post while searching for a way to log error messages.  
>  
> I use the MESSAGE procedure quite a lot. In some long procedures, I often use it as:  
>  
> message, 'Txt', /continue  
>  
> when I want to report an error of some kind but continue with other operations. I'd like to be  
able to log these messages to a file, as they are printed in the terminal when they are  
encountered. It would be nice to have something like a /FILE keyword to MESSAGE, but I  
suspect there's a reason for its inexistence. Any tips?
