> ... whatever the graphics command is here...
> cgPS_Close
>
> The file "myfile.jpg" is created, the intermediate PostScript file is
> deleted automatically, and I have *exactly* what I want. Ah, it feels SO
> good! ;-)
>

> Of course, these commands also work like they always did. So, if your
> fingers are already trained, no worries.
