I have nothing against the NASA routine AL\_Legend for adding legends to graphics displays. I've used it for years, and so has nearly everyone I know. But, I've been feeling guilty about not having a "native" Coyote Graphics solution, and I have long wanted something a bit simpler to understand and use. A new program, cgLegend, may fit the bill. It doesn't have as many features as AL\_Legend, but it does have the "fit and finish" of a Coyote Library program, which I like. You can find documentation here:
