[ENOTTY] Not a typewriter Indicates one or more of the following errors:

- o The file descriptor's file is not a terminal.
- The calling process does not have a controlling terminal.
- o The controlling terminal is no longer associated with the calling process session (tcsetpgrp()).
- o The specified open descriptor is not associated with a character-special device or the specified request does not apply to the kind of object that the specified open descriptor references (ioctl()).
