I just wanted to point out that the version of FINDEX posted here a few weeks ago can be sped up by about 25% by reversing the indexing order of the variable JLIM. That is, by replacing JLIM=LONARR(2,NV) with JLIM=LONARR(NV,2). This is because IDL, (like FORTRAN) is column oriented -- first index varies the fastest. Thanks to Roger Dejus for this suggestion.
