I understand that pv-wave's Linux db_connection toolkit only works for Oracle and sybase. Is there another connection mechanism that can be used to get pv-wave to connect to a postgresql database?

Are there any examples out there? I can google and find this question from in the years 2006 - 2008, but I can't find any answers or examples of how to do this.
