There is nothing special about the Map_Continents routine that is used to put map boundaries on map projections. It simply used PLOTS to draw lines from one point to another, each point expressed in lat/lon coordinates.

It would be quite easy to build your own Map_Planet routine. All you need is a list of the coordinates and, perhaps, a flag to let you know if the "pen" should be up or down.
