> I don't know, it looks like Greek to me :-)

> Setting the font to one gives the correct y title.
>
> Using Coyote Graphics gives me something even goofier:
>
> cgPS_OPEN, file='test.png'
> cgPlot, dist(10), XTITLE='r (cm)', YTITLE='Awesomeness', YRANGE=[0, 3d4]
> cgPS_CLOSE
>
> Again, specifying FONT=1 in the call to cgPS_OPEN fixes things.
>
> I've filed a request for technical support, BTW.
```
